<p>Past AQA Papers</p> <p>Y10</p>	<p>To make sure you are fully focused, put your phone away! 😊</p> <p>Ensure you have the following with you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Squared or lined paper / book • Timer (preferably digital) • Pens, pencils + highlighters <p>Clearly label the exam paper you are completing e.g. AQA SAMS 1 – Reading</p> <p>It is very important to fully try a question or paper before you check your answers against the mark scheme.</p> <p><u>Listening</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remember you have 5 mins to read through the paper and annotate. • Complete the exam in a quiet place away from any noise or distraction. You want to mirror real exam conditions. • If you are struggling you can pause the recording and/or replay tracks. • Once you have tried a paper in exam conditions, access the transcript and go back to questions you struggled on. On Android, press the menu icon at the top right corner and press 6. Create a Profile. 7. On iOS, press Profile in the top left corner and press Create a Profile. 8.
