## Music

### Years 7 and 8

#### 'Protest Music'

Hip Hop/Rap Began in the USA in the 1970s. It is a style of music where the lyrics are spoken rather than sung – a form of rhythmic poetry. Other elements include DJing, turntablism, scratching, beatboxing, and instrumental tracks

#### Task 1:

Listen to the song 2 Pac Changes.

Can you pick out any themes he is rapping about?

Is there a particular line/verse that strikes a chord with you? Why?

How many bars does each verse last for?

#### Task 2:

Write a rap about something we think is unfair or needs to change in the world

### Years 9, 10 and 11

#### 'Making Film sound effects'

- Research the artist Foley (look on google and YouTube)
- Write up a presentation about his work.
- Pick a clip from a film and make a 'sound scape' using body percussion and objects from home to fit the scene.
